ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Entries - Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reserve side of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basic.

AKC Fees - A recording fee in the amount 50 cents and an AKC Service Fee in the amount of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show or Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Refunds - Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Dallas Chihuahua Club, Inc. or the Dog Training Club of Dallas. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specified any conditions as to its acceptance. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. An administrative fee will be charged for cancellation or changes made prior to closing of entries.

Substitute Prizes - The Dallas Chihuahua Club, Inc. reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies and prizes will be awarded in the ring. Any claims of discrepancy for trophies and prizes must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once of any discrepancy.

Judging - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club will not be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise pen.

From the North

Go South on I-35 through downtown Dallas. Stay right when it splits, so that you are going South on Hwy. 67. Pass I-20 and Exit at Cockrell Hill Road (near Jack in the Box). Continue South on the service road. Turn right on Alexander, then right on to Crestside. The dog club on the right has a tall chain link fence. It is a white cement single story building set back on the lot. There is a large sign on the gate.

From the South

Proceed North on Hwy. 67 to Cockrell Hill Road. Exit Cockrell Hill Road and turn left back over the highway. Turn left again so that you are on the South-bound service road. Turn right on Alexander, then right onto Crestside. The dog club on the right has a tall chain link fence. It is a white cement single story building set back on the lot. There is a large sign on the gate.

From the East or West

Take I-20 from the East or West to Hwy. 67 in Duncanville. Go South on Hwy. 67. Cockrell Hill Road will be the first exit. Exit Cockrell Hill Road and continue South on the service road. Turn right on Alexander, and right on Crestside. The dog club on the right has a tall chain link fence. It is a white cement single story building set back on the lot. There is a large sign on the gate.

From the South-Bound Service Road

Turn right on the second street which is Alexander. There are only two streets that turn to the right. Pass the first one and then GO VERY SLOWLY. Most people miss the second turn which is at the end of a small strip shopping center. (There are some small trees which make it hard to see the street until you are upon it.) Turn right on Alexander and STAY RIGHT when it splits. (It curves to the right.) At the split, the street to the right will be Crestside. The dog club has a tall chain link fence. It is a white cement single story building set back on the lot. There is a large sign on the gate.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or leaser of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the Liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth),

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A. K. C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
