Entries - Telegraph, Telephone and Unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reserve side of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry. The club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basic.

AKC Fees - A recording fee in the amount 50 cents and an AKC Service Fee in the amount of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show or Obedience Trial. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Refunds - Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Dallas Chihuahua Club, Inc. or the Sterling Hotel of Dallas. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specified any conditions as to its acceptance. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. An administrative fee will be charged for cancellation or changes made prior to closing of entries.

Substitute Prizes - The Dallas Chihuahua Club, Inc. reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. All trophies and prizes will be awarded in the ring. Any claims of discrepancy for trophies and prizes must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once of any discrepancy.

Judging - Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. The Club will not be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise pen.

Southbound on I-35E, take exit 434B to Regal Row. Turn right on Regal Row and drive nearly 1 mile passing under Hwy 183. The Sterling Hotel is on the right.

Northbound on I-35E, exit left to Hwy 183 (signs for Irving/DFW Airport/TX-183/TX-114). Take the Regal Row exit, turn left under the highway and the Sterling Hotel is on the right.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A. K. C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
